OFFICIAL INTERNATIONAL INDIGENOUS NATION TO NATION TREATY OF "HEALTH AND WELLNESS"

This Official Nation to Nation Indigenous Treaty of "Health and Wellness" is now established between The Sovereign Polynesian Kingdom of Atooi/Hawaiian Kingdom and the undersigned Sovereign Tribal Nations of the Lands contemporarily referred to as the Americas and is signed by and with King/Ali'i Nui Aleka Aipoalani (and his officially appointed representatives) of the Polynesian Kingdom of Atooi/Hawaiian Kingdom, and signed by the Grand or Principal Chiefs of each of the undersigned Tribal Nations.

This Nation to Nation Indigenous Treaty of "Health and Wellness" is established in a truthful, respectful, dignified and honorable manner that promotes goodness, honesty, righteousness, equity and love in the spirit, traditions and ways that our Creator, our ancestors and our elders have always respected and continue to keep.

This Indigenous Treaty of "Health and Wellness" is with the intent of establishing indigenous individual health, tribal community health, national and international health through the use of Traditional Tribal Health Practices & Medicines and Spiritual Ceremony while also utilizing modern Western Medicines and modern information technologies (IT) or digitized health systems. This will also promote indigenous health data sovereignty, private health data security and future indigenous physical and mental health for our elders, families, teenagers, women, children and disabled persons.

This Indigenous Treaty of "Health and Wellness" is further established to cultivate, uphold and promote a true and lasting spirit of peace and friendship between the Sovereign Nation of the Polynesian Kingdom of Atooi/Hawaiian Kingdom and the undersigned Sovereign Tribal Nations of the lands contemporarily referred to as the Americas to mutually share our ancestral traditions, cultures, languages and ceremonies in a manner that protects their integrity and respects the individual cultural norms and beliefs of each of the undersigned Nations as was intended by the Creator.

This Indigenous Treaty of "Health and Wellness" does acknowledge, respect, uphold and honor the spirit, intent and provisions of the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples (UNDRIP), the United Nations Expert Mechanism on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples, the American Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous People (ADRIP) of the Organization of American States, the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, and all health-related rights recognized in binding international instruments (both present and future). This Indigenous "Health and Wellness" Treaty, will acknowledge the right to attain the highest standard of physical, mental and spiritual health in a culturally appropriate manner, and take into account the traditional practices and medicines as well as the individual customs and laws of the undersigned Sovereign Nations. This Treaty does also embrace current and future lawfully and equitably appropriate health documentation, digitized communication and indigenous health data collection related programs, policies and initiatives that shall be established and is subject to the "free, prior and informed consent" of each of the undersigned Sovereign Nations.

All provisions of this Indigenous Treaty of "Health and Wellness", will serve as the framework, foundation and barometer for the establishment of future treaties, agreements, collaborations and partnerships between the undersigned Sovereign Nations and will be conducted not only in a manner and spirit of perpetual truth, honesty and righteousness that seeks to and does serve the mutual interest and benefit of all the undersigned Sovereign Nations but also to ensure integrity and transparency through the utilization of appropriate utilizing current and future technologies and protocols that our Creator, our good spirits and our dearly departed ancestors will honor and respect this agreement and covenant.

May The Creator bless and approve of this Indigenous Treaty of "Health and Wellness" and may each of the undersigned Sovereign Nations share, uphold and protect this Indigenous Treaty of "Health and Wellness" with and for one another in an equitable, righteous, respectful and honorable manner and spirit for as long as the sun does rise and the rivers and the oceans do exist.

For the benefit and in the interest of all of the undersigned Sovereign Nations is this "Indigenous Treaty of Health and Wellness" signed this 27th day, of the 7 the month, of the 2018th year, of the Gregorian Calendar, in the ancestral lands of The Seneca, contemporarily referred to as Niagara Falls, NY .
