Peace Treaty

PREAMBLE

Know ye all people by these presents that we the undersigned Signatories to this **Peace Treaty** fully recognize the Sovereignty and inherent preeminent rights of the original people of the land, Indigenous Peoples, Hereditary Chiefs, Clan Mothers, Spiritual Leaders, Council of Hereditary Chiefs and Heads of States who have a commitment to work together combining collective strengths, knowledge, collective efforts and influence to channel those qualities into one common agenda, which is to set up an economic base to, in the first instance, address poverty, world famine, humanitarian relief, land stewardship and disaster management in the world. Secondly, to have a cohesive working party and realize that the long term effects are fundamental upon having projects, the latter of which must be realistic and viable, and which contribute to the building of economies in order to empower private sovereign nations under the direction of the Great Spirit to provide and care for their people, communities and dependents.

The **Parties** hereby affirm their status and authority to enter into this **Peace Treaty** which is founded upon respect for one another, and recognizes the aspirations and intents of each Party to combine their efforts, strengths, expertise and asset base, in order to establish an economic base for development and enrichment. This **Peace Treaty** is entered into with an absolute commitment to peace, the pursuit of peace and the advancement of peace in the world, and of particular and immediate concern are the world food shortages;

The function of this **Peace Treaty** is to support rural initiatives globally, and better utilization of land (both onshore and offshore), as well as programs to increase fish stocks and other food sources;

This **Peace Treaty** also intends to promote initiatives and research to produce food, using new and advanced technologies for production, storage and distribution to impoverished countries.

This **Peace Treaty** recognizes the spirit of friendship, enabling the **Parties** to cooperate mutually in their respective endeavors for the betterment and uplifting of the people, families, communities and nations of the world.

The Parties have agreed as follows:

Article 1: The relationship between the **Parties** whose signatures are appended herein, shall at all times continue to be governed by a spirit of close friendship.

Article 2: We the undersigned Parties, hereby mutually agree to safeguard, protect and ensure that the integrity of the sovereign treasures assets of value, funds, bankable items and or cultural and intellectual property rights are kept safe, and the rights of ownership are never compromised or minimized, or allowed to be disenfranchised, but shall be held dear and in a transparent manner, and if placed for enhancement that the highest level of international business acumen be employed with full fiduciary responsibility for the same.

Article 3: The sustainability and development projects worldwide will be carried out fully supported by and in cooperation with each other in accordance with the various "**Mutual Project Funding Agreements**". All humanitarian commercial projects will be managed by the parties on an ad-hoc basis.

Article 4: Wherever appropriate, the Parties shall consult each other on matters of mutual interest and strategic importance internationally and in particular this Peace Treaty allows for the support of the licensing of a central bank, a merchant bank and a retail bank.

Article 5: Each Party shall ensure that when hosting special events, conferences, summits and or delegations of the other Parties, every effort of hospitality and decorum commensurate with this level of international finance of co-operation. All beneficiaries, staff, partners, associates and affiliates of the other Parties herein, are accorded preferential status, equitable treatment and full legal protection.

Article 6: The Parties shall continue to work together to enhance and promote the wellbeing and quality of life of their respective peoples and beneficiaries including the support with birth certificates, I.D. cards, drivers licensing and passports.

Article 7: Each party shall consider sympathetic requests from each other for technical, administrative, political and financial assistance in relation to the humanitarian projects and special needs of first nation peoples of the world and other impoverished countries.

Article 8: The Parties shall for as long as the Parties wish, and in such a manner as will enhance the efforts of the other Parties, and shall in no way impair, impede or frustrate the right or efforts of any of the other Parties, to formulate their own foreign aid or investments in relation to each other and the ability of the other Parties in achieving their international aims and objectives, in particular, the Parties will when appropriate and permissible,

- * In the spirit of co-operation, ensure free flow of information concerning international affairs,

- * Undertake to protect each other's business affairs and transactions from all or any external or third party attempts to undermine their respective international rights, privileges and freedom to conduct its lawful business,

- * This includes the setting up of a Chamber of Commerce to protect the cultural and intellectual property rights of each nation.

Article 9: This Peace Treaty describes the relationship between the Parties, which hold each other in a place of high esteem, and the fundamental components are built on mutual respect, understanding and dialog.

Article 10: This Peace Treaty allows for the implementation of the UN Millennium Goals, reaching out to impoverished nations and peoples of the world.

Article 11: The Parties herein agree that there will be significant economic and financial exchanges as a result of this Peace Treaty. The resulting disbursements will form part of this Treaty and will be activated by one or more placements of collateral in the form of Sovereign Guarantees and/or AA+ bank instruments. Lodged or pledged through a Mutual Project Funding Agreement. All proceeds and/or distributions from such financial activity will be disbursed with full transparency without delay or impediment in accordance with the rules and standards of international banking, albeit, in the spirit of absolute trust and goodwill.

Article 12: This **Peace Treaty** is valid for a period of twenty five (25) years, and the **Parties** may amend it at any time upon written agreement herein. The Parties may at any time give to the other Party written notice of desire to terminate or withdraw from this Peace Treaty, in such case, this shall terminate upon the expiration of eighteen (18) months from the date upon which the notice is received and mutually agreed upon by the undersigned Parties. Allowances will be made according to and subject to amicable negotiations in relation to any economic activity that is still transacting, in such cash, termination will be extended accordingly:

Article 13: This Peace Treaty makes allowance for tax treaties, free trade agreements, diplomatic passports and banking licenses, as well as reciprocal embassy status with recipient nation.

Article 14: This Peace Treaty is duly signed and has full force and intent as per the articles herein, which also includes electronic transmissions, The hardcopy will be signed in a formal meeting by the signatories herein.

Article 15: This Peace Treaty will be sealed by smoking the peace pipe in ceremony with the Parties and also the exchange of sacred treasures.

The Parties hereto confirm that this is a legally binding document and having read and understood the terms herein, the Parties identified below affix their signatures hereto and thereby acknowledge and accept the terms and conditions of this agreement.
